SIG MOBILITY ANNUAL"IN-BETWEEN" MEETING 2018; BRIEF REPORT

The SIG Mobility group gathered between 28th and 29th September 2018 at the Glasgow Caledonian University in Scotland. This was the 21st in-between SIG mobility meeting, entitled: 'Rehabilitation in MS: Innovation in Research and Practice'. This meeting was attended by 62 delegates from 13 countries.

The meeting opened on Thursday evening with a civic reception at the historic Glasgow City Chambers, an iconic landmark dating back to the early 1880's. This was followed by two days of fascinating and versatile program consisting of included 6 keynote and 16 free-paper presentations covering work related to: the evaluation of physical activity and exercise interventions on physical and cognitive function; investigating the influence of factors such as ageing, balance, and physical activity on mobility in MS; and the development and evaluation of clinical services to improve mobility in people with MS. In addition, 4 practical workshops offered delegates the chance to learn more about orthotics assessment and Pilates for MS at Revive MS Support, the measurement of energy expenditure, and physical activity monitoring with an emphasis on developing specific metrics for MS populations.

The meeting was extremely well organized thanks to the hard-working team lead by Prof. Lorna Paul. Additionally, a fantastic social event was organized and traditional ceilidh dancing at Sloans, Glasgow's oldest pub, followed dinner, and the delegates' coordination and rhythmic skills were put to the test.

Both the scientific and social content of the meeting were well accepted by the delegates, highlighting the link of research into practice as the major strength of the meeting. Additional apparent credits of the successful meeting were the opportunities given to young researchers to present their (preliminary) works as well as the outstanding opportunities for collegial networking.
